PARKING: The Holiday Inn has an indoor parking lot (enter from Broadway) as well as a parking lot behind the hotel (enter from 8th Ave). The cost of parking for the evening is approximately \$5.00 (Bring your loonies)

As you can appreciate, we have to keep to a strict schedule for this event so that we will arrive in plenty of time for the performance at the Playhouse.

After giving it some thought, your committee quickly realized that it would take considerable time to move 100 people from the banquet, to their cars, across the bridge, to a downtown parking lot and finally into the theatre---ALL AT THE SAME TIME. For this reason, we have reserved buses for transport to and from the theatre. The cost will be \$10, return per person, \$5. for seniors, with the B.C.R.M.T.A. subsidizing some of the cost for you. The advantages of using the bus are:

1. no parking fee (downtown parking usually \$6-\$8)

2. on time pickup and delivery from "front door to front door" (particularly nice if it rains!)

3. a very comfortable ride, relaxing and chatting with your friends

4. no worry about driving after having a "beverage" with your dinner

We are assuming that most of you will want to purchase a ticket for the bus and avoid the car hassle. We will be collecting the bus fare at the beginning of the evening so that there will be no delays after the banquet is finished.




